Seek medical care immediately

If you suspect type 1 diabetes, seek medical care immediately. A simple blood test can quickly provide an answer.



Type 1 diabetes is the most common life-threatening chronic disease among children in Sweden, with incidence rates increasing particularly among younger children. Simultaneously, the number of children admitted with severe acid poisoning – a condition that can quickly become life-threatening – is also rising.
